

YMCA CAMP OCOEE

The seeds being planted at YMCA Camp Ocoee through renovations will yield a beautiful crop that can be seen in the hearts of individuals, families, groups, and communities at large – and the Program Center is where much of the mission of Camp Ocoee will come to life.



A new **Program Center** will be the focal point of camp – the gathering place where activities, groups and memories bloom. This new 6,000 square foot program center will provide not just additional space, but also a central point for camp check-outs, shaded indoor activities, gym space and new rental facility year-round.

The Program Center will serve not only camp children, but larger groups around the community including school groups, family reunions/events, church groups, corporate retreats and much more.





To provide additional housing for both summer camp and school-year programs, the new **Treehouse Village** will provide a unique experience for 48 campers each summer. This represents the final stage of Camp Ocoee's master plan.

PHASE COMPLETIONS

To complete the reinvestment in Camp Ocoee, philanthropic investments will be needed by private and public sources, including people just like you. Leadership-level and matching gifts set the pace.
